Membership Options

Please select the appropriate membership level below. You will have a chance to review your selection and the corresponding dues on the next page prior to your credit card being charged.

- A Planting Membership entitles the member(s) to one 4' x 8' planting bed and requires the
 member household to offer at least ten (10) volunteer hours per season in a combination of
 tasks offered by the garden that fits the abilities and skills of the household's member(s).
- An **Elevated Planting Bed** is designed for those who have trouble bending or kneeling; half the size; 3 available. Same volunteer hours.
- Joining as part of the Garden Collective means that your garden bed is not held individually but combined with others and worked communally under the guidance of experienced gardeners. Collective members choose crops together in communal work hours each week, with many vegetables. Collective members may also work in the Collective beds and harvest whenever they wish. Beginning this year, inexperienced gardeners who join are required to spend their first year gardening with the Community Garden as part of the Collective.
- Supporting Members are those who opt not to undertake the maintenance of a planting bed
 and the associated responsibilities, but contribute funds (as well as time and expertise, as they
 are able) to support HGNC's efforts. Supporting members are welcome at all Members Only as
 well as community events.
- Scholarship Assistance: HGNC considers financial hardship and offers scholarship assistance up to the full cost of either a Planting Bed Membership or of a Supporting Membership on a pay what you can basis. The key fee is still \$5.00. (non-refundable)
- Additional Contributions help us fund programs, maintain and improve the garden, and subsidize fees for members who are unable to pay the full price of membership.
- If you are applying for planting membership for the first time this year, please wait until you know whether a planting bed or a space in the Collective is available for you before you submit payment. Please do let us know of your interest of being on the Waitlist by filling out an application and returning it. Places on the Waitlist are determined by the date request is received and place of residence priority is given to residents of SW Germantown, then of the city of Philadelphia.
- Returning Members may switch between Planting Beds, the Elevated Planting Beds, and the Garden Collective. Request selection you want for the 2023 season.

IMPORTANT DATES about Renewal and Signing Up for 2023 (a reminder):

- Membership Renewal opens Feb 26.
- Membership Renewal deadline to keep your bed or place in the Garden Collective from 2022: March 6. Returning members will pay the \$40 membership fee or request scholarship assistance and submit membership agreements by March 6 in order to maintain use of the same bed from the previous year. This date is a couple weeks before the Spring Gathering, a required meeting for all new members, and encouraged for all members, held Saturday, March 25 from 10 a.m. to noon. The meeting will be held at the garden, weather permitting. Rain location: the new Germantown Weavers Way office space, 326B W Chelten Avenue.
- If membership has not been renewed by March 6, availability of a planting bed and use of the same bed is not guaranteed. Beds will be reassigned beginning Tuesday, March 7.
- Planting bed holders need to have their beds cultivated by May 31 or they forfeit the use of their planting bed to someone on the Wait List.
- The garden season ends on Nov 1. To minimize the spread of fungus and other garden diseases spreading throughout the garden, planting bed holders must clear their beds of all summer growth before this date. Any who want to use a cover crop or who have overwintering crops in their bed may seek permission of Membership to extend their growing season beyond November 1. Other crops left in planting beds beyond November 1 are donated to City Harvest.
